


Behind the Scenes: Translating Research into Policy & Practice

ABSTRACT

For over a century, the mission of the Annals of the American Academy of Political and Social Science has been to foster dialogue between the academic community and policymakers around a variety of pressing social issues. Using the recently published issue "The Great Experiment: Realigning Criminal Justice in California and Beyond" co-edited by Professors Charis Kubrin and Carroll Seron as a jumping off point, this panel will explore the ways in which scholarship may speak to policy. The panelists will share their experiences and strategies for bringing research into the public dialogue.
